



COURSE OUTLINE

In accordance with the department of professional and occupational regulation (DPOR) requirements this course is 200 hours and includes permanent eyebrows (powder brows), eyeliner, lip liner and full lip color. Kit is included with tuition: Rotary machine, pigments, needles, and more. Upon successful completion you will receive a certificate which will allow you to take the state board exam. In order to receive your state license, you will need to pass the state board theory exam.

A minimum of 50 performances shall be completed as part of the permanent cosmetic tattooing instruction, including two eyebrow procedures, two microblading procedures, two lip liners, one lip color, and one full lip. Two eyebrows count as one performance; two eye liners count as one performance; one lip counts as one performance).
